

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!!!! FOR NEWLY FORMED MUSKEGON RIVER PATROL

A newly formed River Patrol has been created to deal with problems on the Muskegon River. Many issues have been occurring for the last several years. These issues include trespassing, nudity, foul language and littering. Law enforcement officials in Newaygo County have joined with the DNR to form a volunteer group to help patrol the river. Being part of this group will only entail a few hours of your time. You would be working with members from law enforcement and the DNR. 2014 ROAD NEWS

Now that the warmer weather is here the Township's annual road improvement, repair and maintenance program will soon be underway. On April 22, the Township Board approved \$147,584 for road repairs and improvements. The Township Board also plans to consider additional funding for road work at its May 13, 2014 meeting. These projects will be completed by the crews of the Newaygo County Road Commission and/or its contracted services.

The specific list of road projects for 2014 is still under review with the Newaygo County Road Commission. When the projects have been finalized the township will post this information on its website: www.brookstownship.org.

In addition to this work, the Township will spend approximately \$16,000 for the dust control program on unpaved local roads this year (road brining). The first brining application will be in early June, followed by a second application 6-8 weeks later.

Thanks also to Kelly Smith (Manager, Newaygo County Roads) for his assistance in determining the most appropriate construction methods for completing these projects.
